
Topic / Issue: Enabling WAN based Remote Telnet on Bintec Routers

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This article explains how to allow a remote telnet session into a Bintec's router via the WAN interface.

When NAT is enabled, Telnet functions to the LAN IP interface are disabled. This blocks remote (internet) management of the router.

To allow an administrator remote telnet access you will need to configure the following virtual port settings.

Log into router and type **setup**

Select **IP** from main menu

=>Select **Network Address Translation**

=> Select the Partner Profile that you want the NAT filter applied to.

=> Select Requested From Outside

=>Select **Add** to configure a virtual port.

-Select **Telnet** from available services.

-leave most parameters blank except for:

Internal Address = 127.0.0.0 (This is the Loopback

address of the router)

Mask = 255.255.255.255

Internal Port = ANY

Now Save the configuration

You will now be able to remotely telnet into the Bintec router via a remote (internet) connection.
