The Following should be used as a guide to identifying the feature supported on your print server.

Newer Models have code like:

PSE1S2P-BNUAS /DS

PSHX3P-BNUAS /DS

PSE - Print Server Ethernet

PSHX - Print Server Fast Ethernet

1S - Number of Serial ports

3P or xP - Number of Parallel ports

BNUAS /DS - Bi-directional , Novell Bindary & NDS, Unix (TCP/IP), AppleTalk, Windows (SMB)

Older models had codes like:

PSE1S2P-FNU

PSE1P-N /DS

PSE - Print Server Ethernet

2P or xP - Number of Parallel ports

1S - number of Serial ports

F - N/A (obsolete) Unidirectional

B - Bi-directional

N - Novell Bindary (IPX)

U - Unix & NT (TCP/IP)

A - AppleTalk

/DS - Novell NDS
