

The following Terms and Conditions apply to all ZCSE Part II attendees:

- 1. For the purpose of this document "course" refers to the Zultys Certified Systems Expert (ZCSE) Part II technical training course.
- 2. Alloy takes <u>online submissions</u> expressing an interest in attending the course. Individual applications are assessed for suitability. Course places are limited to a specific size. Applicants must hold a position in the technical department of a Reseller who is a current Authorised Vidyo Reseller. Applicants must have an appropriate level of technical competence, particularly in configuration of IP networks and network devices. Course places will be offered to qualifying applicants on a 'first in best dressed' basis. Attendance on the course will be confirmed by email.
- 3. Course applicants must have successfully completed the ZCSE Part I technical training course.
- 4. This course has a significant component of practical 'live' systems-based instruction, and therefore course places are limited small class sizes. Attendees must bring their own Windows laptop computer (including power adapter) on all days of the course.
- 5. Maximum number of participants per course is as specified in the course details on Alloy's website (www.alloy.com.au/training).
- 6. Course fees must be paid in advance of attending the course.
- 7. Payments for a place on the course are accepted only by Credit Card (VISA, MasterCard, Bankcard and Amex are accepted). Alloy processes credit card payments upon allocation of a place on the course normally within two business days from registration.
- 8. Course Fees.
