2 Requirements

Quadro's Streaming Hold Music feature allows the on-hold party to listen to the music streamed by an external RTP streamer playing MP3 files rather than the pre-recorded voice stored on the Quadro. There is a possibility to play different streams for each extension, to play very long audio files and to allow the playlist selection to be easily changed.

Epygi's EMS (Epygi Media Streamer) is a software application allowing the on-hold party to listen to the voice streamed by an external RTP streamer. The EMS playlist can sequentially stream several MP3 files to a specified unicast or multicast IP address/port. The EMS application resides on a PC and it can be easily and quickly configured. The Quadro will be configured to 'tune-in' to the RTP port specified in the EMS and the Music on Hold settings for each extension can be set accordingly.

2.1 System Requirements

The following specifications are required for the proper operation of the Epygi's EMS:

- MS Windows XP and Windows Vista
- TCP connection

2.2 Quadro Software Requirements

The Streaming Hold Music feature is applicable for Quadro2x, Quadro4x/16x, Quadro6L, Quadro4Li, QuadroM32x running FW 5.1.17 and higher. For QuadroM8L, QuadroM26x, QuadroM26xi, QuadroM12Li running 5.2.7 and higher.
